**DIVISION REORIENTATION ON THE SPECIAL SCIENCE ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS (SSES) PROJECT CUM TRAINING ON UPGRADING TEACHERS' COMPETENCIES IN TEACHING ENGLISH, MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE**

**To:** Public Schools District Supervisors

1. The Department of Education, Division of Nueva Ecija shall conduct a **Division Reorientation on the Special Science Elementary Schools (SSES) Project Cum Training on Upgrading Teachers' Competencies in Teaching Elementary English, Mathematics, and Science** at Provincial Capitol Amphitheater, Old Capitol Compound, Cabanatuan City on December 11-13, 2014.
2. The training aims to provide the Special Science Elementary School (SSES) teachers with the knowledge on the SSES Project and to improve their teaching competencies.  
Specifically, the training aims to:
