**DIVISION 2015 WELLNESS CAMPUS PROGRAM COMPETITION**

**To: Public Secondary School Principals**

1. The Wellness Campus is an advocacy project of Nestle Philippines that aims to create awareness on Wellness and the balance of Physical Fitness and Good Nutrition among high school students. The Wellness was implemented in partnership with the Department of Education- Region III, Nestle Philippines, and Greatfil Team Inc.
2. In this regard, we started our 2015 Division Wellness Campus Program last Aug 7, 2015 in all public high schools.
3. All participating students must fill up a waiver and Parental Consent form and submit to the division office on or before August 28, 2015.
4. All schools must submit their video or documentation of Wellness Program in the flag raising ceremony and in PE/Health class including the interview to their students. All interested schools who wants to join the competition must submit another video of the dance entry to the division competition following the contest mechanics that is recorded in a CD/DVD. All videos must be submitted on Sept 17, 2015.
5. A team from Nestle Philippines, Greatfil Inc. and from DepEd division office will visit all participating schools to witness their actual performance and also to check on the nutrition module implementation from August 17, 2014 to September 16, 2015.
6. The division winner will be announced on September 24, 2015 and will receive cash prize as support to the schools' Health and Wellness Program. Criteria for judging at the division level will be as follows:

Creativity (choreo/theme)	25%
On-time implementation	25%
Executuion during Flag Ceremonies	25%
Nutrition Module Implementation	<u>25%</u>
Total	100%

7. There will be one (3) winners per division. The Schools Division Superintendent, Assistant Schools Division Superintendent (Secondary), Chief of the Curriculum Development Division, the MAPEH supervisor, and the representative from Nestle and Greatfil Team Inc. will select the best schools in the division. The prize for the Division Wellness 2015 Competition will be P20,000 (P10,000-first prize, P7,000 – second prize and P3,000 third prize).
8. The champion in the division will qualify to participate in the 2015 Regional Wellness Campus Showdown that will be conducted on Sept 28, 2015.
9. Wide dissemination of this memorandum is requested to ensure the full participation of all concerned.
