**2015 DIVISION SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE
(Elementary and Secondary)**

- TO: Public Schools District Supervisors
Public and Private Secondary School Principals/School Heads/OICs/TICs
Public and Private Elementary School Principals/School Heads/TICs/OICs
1. This is to announce the conduct of 2015 Division Schools Press Conference in both elementary and secondary schools on September 22-23, 2015 at Cabiao National High School, Cabiao, Nueva Ecija.
 2. The conference aims to:
 - a. demonstrate understanding of the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavors and approaches;
 - b. provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for students interested in pursuing journalism as a career;
 - c. promote responsible journalism and fair and ethical use of social media;
 - d. enhance the journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competitions; and
 - e. select the division participants to the forthcoming Regional Schools Press Conference.
 3. The conference activities shall include the following:
 - a. Individual contests: News Writing, Editorial Writing, Sports Writing, Feature Writing, Science and Health Writing, Editorial Cartooning, Photojournalism and Copyreading and Headline Writing
 - b. Group Categories: Radio Broadcasting and Scriptwriting, & Collaborative Desktop Publishing
 4. Participants to this conference are top five (5) winners in the congressional district level for the individual categories and top two (2) winners in the group categories.
 5. Participants to the group categories are required to bring their own laptop, printer, connector and other gadgets necessary for their rehearsals and layout respectively.
 6. Each contestant in photojournalism is required to bring any digital camera (point and shoot only) with a maximum of 16 megapixels, unloaded memory card, card reader, camera cable and laptop. DSLR and other high-end cameras are **NOT** allowed. Contestants will load the empty memory card in front of the evaluator. They are allowed to take ten pictures but only six shots (including the control shot) will be submitted as official entries. Captions should be encoded by the contestants upon uploading the photos.
 7. Editorial cartooning contestant shall bring his/her own drawing paraphernalia like pencil and ruler. Oslo paper will be provided by the host school. Only pencils should be used as main drawing tool.

8. For purposes of determining the real potential of the contestants, they shall be allowed to compete in a maximum of two individual categories. Participants who will win in two categories shall select only one category he/she prefers to join in the regional level.
9. Top five (5) winners in the individual categories shall be chosen but only top three winners will compete in the RSPC. In case one of the top three winners will not be able to compete in the regional level, the fourth place shall take the slot.
10. For group categories, top three winners shall be selected but only the First Place winners shall compete in the RSPC.
11. During the contest proper, participants are not allowed to go out of the contest rooms, while coaches, advisers, trainers and parents are not allowed to stay inside the contest rooms nor in the shooting area for photojournalism. Likewise, cellular phones and other communication devices shall not be allowed.
12. Deadline of entries to the Search for Outstanding School Paper Advisers and Campus Journalists will be on September 30, 2015 at the Division Office, while deadline of entries to group contest (school paper) will be on December 11, 2015.
13. The host school will provide extra rooms for participants who wish to stay overnight. Concerned participants should coordinate with the EPSes in-charge of journalism earlier than the schedule for their accommodation.
14. Enclosure No. 1 contains the list of facilitators and Enclosure No. 2 contains the criteria for the Search for Outstanding School Paper Adviser and Campus Journalist.
15. The participants are advised to bring their own provisions for lunch & snacks. A minimal registration fee of **FIFTY PESOS (P 50.00)** shall be collected from each participant, school paper adviser, teacher/coach to defray expenses for the certificates, honoraria and meals for speakers/evaluators and other incidental expenses chargeable against local school funds/Journalism Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
16. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is enjoined.
