**ORIENTATION ON TEEN HEALTH KIOSK (THK)
ESTABLISHMENT**

To: All Secondary Schools Principals/TIC

1. The Department of Health (DOH) through the Kalusugan Pangkalahatan aims to bring health care advocacies to every corner of the country by 2016. As part of this strategy, the Provincial Health Office and the Nueva Ecija DOH Office in partnership with our development partner LuzonHealth will conduct an **Orientation on the stablishment of teen Health Kiosk (THK) as part of the Adolescent and Youth Health Program (AYHP)**. This activity will serve as a venue to bring together all **City and Municipal Health Officers (C/MHOs) and all Principals** of Public National High Schools of Nueva Ecija to generate collective efforts, strategies and plans to address the adolescent and youth challenges of the province.
2. THKs will serve as an information hub, counseling nook and promoter of teen health consultations and strategically established in school, community, health facility and hospital. Moreover, the kiosk will contain up-to-date, relevant, accurate and comprehensive materials on the current issues and concerns of adolescents. Furthermore, the establishment of THKs is a very timely program because we need to address the rising incidence of teenage pregnancy in our province.

In line with this, all principals and school heads from all public national high school are invited to attend a one day activity **“Orientation on Teen Health Kiosk Establishment” on September 10, 2015 for CD 1 & 2, and September 11, 2015 for CD 3 & 4 to be held at Rico Fajardo Hall, NEUST, Sumacab, Cabanatuan City**. Registration will start at 8:00 in the morning and the program will start at 9:00am to end at 5:00pm.
4. Meals and snacks during the said activity will be provided by DOH. Transportation and per diem before and after the activity will be charged from the participants' respective sending agency.
5. Your support to ensure the successful implementation of this program is sought for.
