**Health and Nutrition Program
Contest Rules and Regulations**

WHO MAY ENTER?

The contest is open to Grades I-III pupils.

MUST ARTWORK BE ORIGINAL?

Yes. Artwork will be done on the spot, must be original, and must be created by the student without assistance from others. Artwork cannot be copied or traced from a book or other material. Photos and computer-generated graphics will be disqualified.

WHAT TYPE/MEDIUM OF ART ENTRY IS ACCEPTABLE?

Black and white or color artwork depicting the theme "Healthy Teeth, A Factor to Academic Excellence".

WHAT SIZE SHOULD THE ENTRY BE?

Entries should be a minimum of 8 ½ x 11 inches and cannot exceed 11 x 17 inches.

WILL ENTRIES BE RETURNED?

No. Entries become sole property of Division Office.

HOW WILL THE ENTRIES BE JUDGED?

Entries will be judged on Originality (30%), Creativity (25%), Imagination (20%) and Best rendering of the theme (25%).

Decision of the judges is final.

World Food Day (Poster Making Contest)

Theme: "Social Protection and Agriculture: Breaking the cycle of rural poverty"

Criteria:

- Originality 20%
- Visual Impact 20%
- Creativity Use of Agricultural & Fishery Products 30%
- Relevance to the theme 30%

***The contest is open to all public Grades IV-VI not older than 12 years old.**

***Materials to be used:**

1. Illustration Board 20" x 30"
2. Any art medium except oil and water color
3. Agricultural and fishery products
(e.g. palay grains, mongo, squash seeds, corn, kernels, husks, sea shells, dried seaweeds, etc.)

Note:

- A poster with NO indicated theme shall be disqualified.
- The participant shall include the brief description/explanation of the finished design written in English or Filipino to be posted at the back of the poster.
