RE: SCHEDULE OF ATHLETIC MEETS**

1. Please be informed of the new schedule of Central Luzon Regional Athletic Association Meet (CLRAA) on February 2016.
2. In line with this, there will be changes in the schedule of the Athletic Meets in the division including the Sports Events in the Provincial Athletic Meet for the School Year 2015.
3. The preliminary meets shall be scheduled as follows:
  - 2.1 Congressional District I-IV Meets:
    - 1.2.1. CD I – Host: Guimba Dist./HS – September 4-5
    - 1.2.2. CD II – Host: Carranglan Dist/HS – September 11-12
    - 1.2.3. CD III – Host: NEHS – September 18-19
    - 1.2.4. CD IV – Host: Cabiao Dist/HS – October 6-7
  - 2.2 Provincial Athletic Meet – November 25-27, 2015
  - 2.3 School Based Athletic Training – Nov 28, 2015 - Jan 26, 2016
  - 2.4 Division Athletic Training – Jan 27, 2016 – Feb. 5, 2016
  - 2.5 CLRAA MEET – February 7-12, 2016 (Tentative)
4. All CD Athletic Track Events shall be held in Nueva Ecija Sports Complex, Palayan City on November 25-27, 2015.
5. All Tennis events in the Divisional Meet (Elem. & Sec. B/G levels) will be played at Nueva Ecija Tennis Association (NETA) Courts following the same date of the Divisional Meet.
6. There are cases that the event or sports are not played in the lower meet if there are no entry players from other schools or districts. It will be automatically played in the division level. (e.g. arnis, taekwondo, gymnastics, lawn tennis, sepak takraw girls, boxing and swimming)
7. The ranking procedure will follow the system of Palarong Pambansa in computing the medals gained and not by point system. This must be applied in the lower meet.

8. All PESS school/district coordinators are encouraged to invite private schools' participation in the conduct of lower meets in their respective municipality/district.
9. All the competing players and teams in all events will be ranked according to the Athletic Ranking Committee (ARC) to be headed by the Technical Managers (TM's) and shall be assisted by the Technical Records Committee (TRC) and the Screening Committee) as members.
10. The final selection of players and coaches/chaperones in each sport event shall be done by the ARC and they shall submit their recommendations to the Athletic Referee for his final approval immediately after the end of the games of the Divisional Athletic Meet.
11. The schedule of **Division Screening on athletes' documents** for Provincial Meet will be on **November 18-20, 2015**. Please submit all documents to the Division Screening Committee before the stated date in the division office.
12. Provision for the granting of service credits to all teachers who rendered services during schools sports training and competition shall be implemented for DepED Order No. 53, s.2003. (Saturdays and Sundays only)
