
**DIVISION TRAINING ON STRATEGIES AND APPROACHES IN TEACHING ESP IN BOTH

2. The training aims to:
- intensify the importance of acquiring knowledge and skills through the strategies and approaches in teaching ESP (Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao);
 - enhance the quality of transfer of learning magnified by quality performance from the learners; and
 - develop into the learners proper virtues in the early stage.
3. Participants to this training are:
- Grade 1 and Grade 3 teachers and Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao Coordinators (3 per district) for elementary; and
 - Values Education Department Heads/Coordinators for secondary.
4. The training is free of charge. Foods, materials and other expenses relative to this training shall be charged against the Division Inset Funds, while traveling expenses of the participants shall be charged against school MOOE or other local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
