**DIVISION TRAINING ON REVISITING THE NATIONAL
KINDERGARTEN CURRICULUM**

To: Public Schools District Supervisors

1. The Department of Education, Schools Division of Nueva Ecija shall conduct a **Division Training on Revisiting the National Kindergarten Curriculum** on November 11, 2015 for Congressional Districts I & II and November 12, 2015 for Congressional Districts III & IV at Talavera Central School, Talavera North District, Talavera, Nueva Ecija.
2. The objective of this in-service training is to provide untrained Kindergarten teachers updates on the content and proper utilization of National Kindergarten Curriculum (NKC) to help them improve and enhance their level of competencies in handling kindergarten pupils.
Specifically, the training aims to:
 - a. Update the Kindergarten teachers on the current trends and issues relating to learning content, and on the pedagogical methods of kindergarten education;
 - b. Enhance teaching skills in terms of techniques, strategies, and approaches in handling Kindergarten Education pupils; and
 - c. Realize the importance of teaching kindergarten effectively in the achievement level of learners.
3. The participants to this training are all untrained kindergarten teachers together with their respective District Kindergarten Coordinator.
4. No registration fee shall be collected. Meals of the participants and materials relative to this division training shall be charged to Division INSET Funds while transportation of the participants shall be charged against school's MOOE / local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
