  - a. determine the establishment, sustainability, operation, existence of industrial arts shop and involvement of pupils in project making.
  - b. recognize the best implementer and most sustainable industrial arts programs and projects with the following awards:
    - b.1. Outstanding Industrial Arts Teachers, Coordinators, Department Head/Area Chair and School Head
    - b.2. Best Implementer of Industrial Arts Programs and Projects
    - b.3. Most sustainable Industrial Arts Programs and Projects in relation to the following categories:
      - standard shop (2 classrooms 7m x 14m)
      - sub-standard shop (1 classroom 7m x 7m)
      - improvised shop
