**ORIENTATION SEMINAR ON ADOLESCENT IMMUNIZATION
WITH STAKEHOLDERS**

To: All District Supervisors
All Secondary Schools Principals/TIC

1. The Department of Health (DOH) in collaboration with the Department of Education (DepED) and Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) initiated vaccination among adolescents in 2013. Measles-Mumps-Rubella (MMR) and Tetanus-Diphtheria (Td) were given to high school students of public secondary schools. MMR and Td were introduced as an important immunization strategy toward the control of vaccine preventable diseases specifically elimination of measles and maternal-neonatal tetanus.
2. In relation to this, a nationwide adolescent vaccination of Grade 1 and Grade 7 public school students will be conducted on August 1, 2015. Students will be screened and will be given one (1) dose of measles containing vaccine and tetanus-diphtheria vaccine.
3. Orientation will be done first by DepED and DOH before the vaccination will take place with our stakeholders at Rico Fajardo Hall, NEUST, Sumacab, Cabanatuan City on the following dates:

May 11, 2015 = Elementary Schools Principals of Cuyapo1, Cuyapo2, Guimba East, Guimba West, Licab, Nampicuan and Aliaga Districts

May 12, 2015 = Elementary Schools Principals of Carranglan, Llanera, Lupao, Pantabangan, Rizal, Talugtog and Quezon Districts

May 13, 2015 = Elementary Schools Principals Bongabon, Gabaldon, Gen Natividad, Laur, Palayan, Sta Rosa and Sto Domingo Districts

May 14, 2015 = Elementary Schools Principals of Cabiao, Gen Tinio, Jaen, Penaranda, San Antonio, San Isidro, Sam Leonardo and Zaragoza Districts

May 15, 2015 = Elementary Schools Principals of Talavera north and Talavera South Districts and all Secondary Schools Principals

May 18, 2015 = All Private Elementary Schools Principals of Nueva Ecija

May 19, 2015 = All Private Secondary Schools Principals of Nueva Ecija

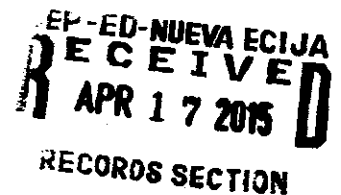
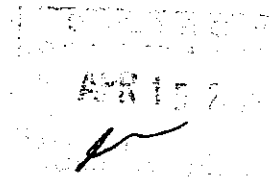
