**GEOMETRY FOR TEACHERS**  
**A Training-Workshop on Theory, Technology, Application,**  
**Competitions, Assessment, and Problem Solving**

1. The Division **GEOMETRY FOR TEACHERS: A Training-Workshop on Theory, Technology, Applications, Competitions, Assessment and Problem Solving** will be Conducted and held at Amphitheater, old Capitol Compound, Cabanatuan City on May26-28, 2015.
2. The training program shall endeavor to attain the following objectives:
  - a. to equip teachers with theory, applications and program solving skills in Geometry and related Math topic.
  - b. to encourage pedagogical change from traditional to an inquiry or discovery based and experiential learning in Geometry.
  - c. to prepare teacher coaches in different Mathematics Competitions particularly in the concepts of Geometry.
  - d. to integrate ICT in teaching Mathematics with the use of Mathematics software (geogebra, graphcalc...) and;
  - e. to provide a continuing support and collaboration from among the teachers on developing a learning experiences to our students towards the twin goals of Mathematics education.
3. Participants in this training-workshop are Mathematics teachers (one per school). They are advised to be at the venue at 8:00 am for registration. In addition, they are required to bring laptop for technology integration.
4. Expenses relative to the training shall be charged to INSET Fund of the Division, however, the participants will shoulder the transportation expenses chargeable to the local school MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
