DIVISION MASS TRAINING OF GRADE 10 TEACHERS OF PRIVATE SECONDARY SCHOOLS ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE K TO 12 BASIC EDUCATION CURRICULUM

1. Pursuant to the implementation of K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum, a Division Mass Training of Grade 10 Teachers is scheduled on May 25, 26 & 27, 2015 at St. Stephen's Academy, Laur, Nueva Ecija.
2. The objectives of this training are:
 - a. provide teachers with a concrete understanding of Grade 10 curriculum framework, learning standards and competencies, assessment and teaching plans;
 - b. equip them with necessary skills, creative and innovative ways on how the K to 12 Curriculum can be localized without compromising the philosophy of the total learner development; and
 - c. provide them with opportunities to acquire and demonstrate the values that will guide the teachers in the effective delivery of the curriculum and their role as facilitators of learning.
3. The participants to this training are all Grade 10 teachers in all private secondary schools in the Division of Nueva Ecija.
4. A registration fee of P950.00 will be collected from each participant to cover expenses for materials, snacks for three days, honorarium of speakers, venue and other incidental expenses. All participants are expected to bring their own packed lunch.
5. Principals/School Heads should assure this office that all teacher-attendees are in good health and not pregnant so that their full and active participation in the said training could be observed.
