**2015 NATIONAL DISASTER CONSCIOUSNESS MONTH (NDCM)**

COORDINATORS

1. In observance of the celebration of **2015 National Disaster Consciousness Month (NDCM)** with the theme *"Pamilya at Pamayanang Handa, Katuwang sa Pag-unlad ng Bansa"*, all **PSDS, District (Elementary) and High School DRRM Coordinators** are hereby enjoined to attend an Orientation Seminar on Disaster Risk Reduction Management Program on July 20, 2015 at DepEd Division of Nueva Ecija Conference Hall, Cabanatuan City.
2. The said activity will include orientation on:
  - a. Disaster Risk Reduction Coordination and Management Protocol (DepEd Order No. 21,s.2015);
  - b. Student-Led School Watching and Hazard Mapping (DepEd Order No. 23, s. 2015); and
  - c. Family Earthquake Preparedness (DepEd Order No.27, s. 2015);
3. Schedule for participants are as follows:

4. Relative expenses to be incurred during the Orientation Seminar including provision of snacks shall be charged to the Division In-Service Training fund. Cost of Travel and transportation shall be charged against Local MOOE. All expenditures are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Likewise, you are hereby encouraged to undertake the following activities in your respective schools to emphasize disaster risk reduction and management education such as, but not limited to, the following:
  - a. Display of streamers indicating this year's theme;
  - b. Organize a Student-Led School Watching and Hazard Mapping;
  - c. Conduct of orientation on the different health hazards;

- d. Devoting of time for class discussion on preparedness, mitigation and prevention during the rainy season;
  - e. Conduct of symposium or forum on DRRM; and
  - f. Conduct of related activities to ensure heightened awareness and consciousness among school administrators, teachers, personnel, and school children nationwide on what to do before, during, and after the occurrence of all forms of possible hazards in your respective areas.
6. All PSDS, District (Elementary) and High School DRRM Coordinators are expected to actively participate in the said activities and implement the same in their respective areas.
