**JOURNALISM TRAINING PROGRAM FOR SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS AND
CAMPUS JOURNALISTS FOR PRIVATE ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS**

To: Education Program Supervisors
Journalism Trainers
Private Elementary
School Administrators/ Principals/ Heads

1. Pursuant to RA 7079 otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991, the Journalism Training Program for School Paper Advisers and Campus Journalist spearheaded by the Nueva Ecija Private Pre -Elementary& Elementary Schools Association (NEPPESA)will be conducted at REH Montessori School, Talavera, Nueva Ecija on August 7-8, 2015.
2. The Division Training aims to:
 - a. hone the journalistic skills of teacher-advisers and campus journalists;
 - b. equip the teacher-advisers and campus journalists with the necessary skills and proficiency in Editorial Writing, Editorial Cartooning, Science and Health Writing, Photojournalism, Copyreading and Headline Writing, Sports, News, Feature Writing and Radio Broadcasting; and
 - c. orient new teacher-advisers on school paper management.
3. Participants to this training program are:
 - a. elementary school paper advisers
 - b. campus journalists (two (2) students per individual category and 5-7 members for broadcasting)
4. A registration fee of five hundred pesos (500Php.) shall be collected from each participant to cover the expenses for two days such as lunch and snacks, honoraria, travelling expenses of the speakers, certificates, supplies and materials and other incidental expenses.
5. Participants in Photojournalism must bring white cartolina, black marker, pencil and a maximum of 16 megapixel camera with an empty memory card. An additional 150Php shall be collected for the developing fee.
6. Editorial Cartooning participants must bring oslo paper and other drawing paraphernalia.
7. Attached are the training matrix and the list of speakers.
8. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is enjoined.
