2. The activity aims to:

 - c. Benchmark on its capacity in upholding solidarity among all members of DepEd community through a showcase of their talents.
3. Participants to this activity are the PSDSes, School Heads, Faculty Presidents of each school, and the contestants to the three competitions. Participants are required to wear maong jeans and white polo shirt during the event.

Contest Mechanics

General Contest Rules:

1. There are three contest categories namely; dance contest, duet singing competition and the search for "Talentadong DepEd personnel".
2. The contests are open to all **permanent** Deped personnel such as school heads, teachers, or non-teaching personnel; however, there will be no specific categories for each of them. There will only be separate categories in the elementary and secondary levels.
3. Top three winners from each category will be recognized in the elementary and top three winners in the secondary level respectively.
4. There will be one (1) representative/pair from each of the four Congressional Districts, and the representative from the non-teaching personnel.
5. All the four CDs will conduct their own elimination rounds to determine their contestants who will compete in the Division Level.
6. Each competition will have specific time allotment, and those who will exceed the required time will receive two-point deduction from their total scores for every excess minute or a fraction thereof. Time allotment will begin the moment the accompaniment/music started, or the moment they started their performance for the talent search.
7. No contestant is allowed to participate in two or more contests.
8. Costumes must be decent and appropriate for the competition.
9. It is the responsibility of the contestants to signify their intention of joining the contest by showing up an hour before the contest proper and make necessary arrangements with the sound system for their music/accompaniment.
10. Professional dancers/singers/performers are disqualified from joining the contests. Participants who are found to have performed as "professionals" will face outright disqualification. A professional dancer/singer/performer is someone who is financially compensated for his/her performance either in public or in private.

12. The use of pyrotechnic gadgets, smoke or combustible and other dangerous materials as props is not allowed.
13. The decision of the board of judges is **final and irrevocable**.
