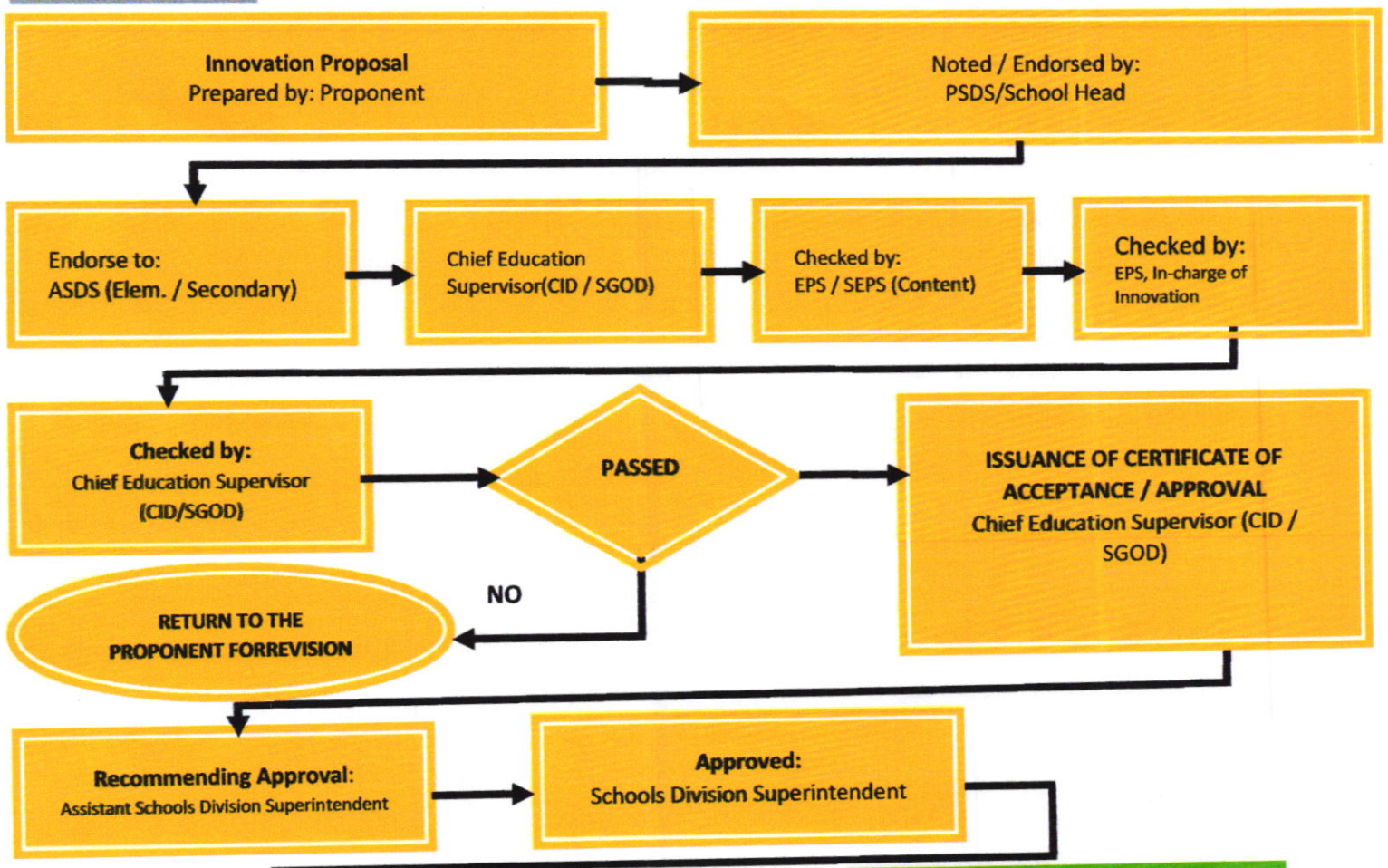

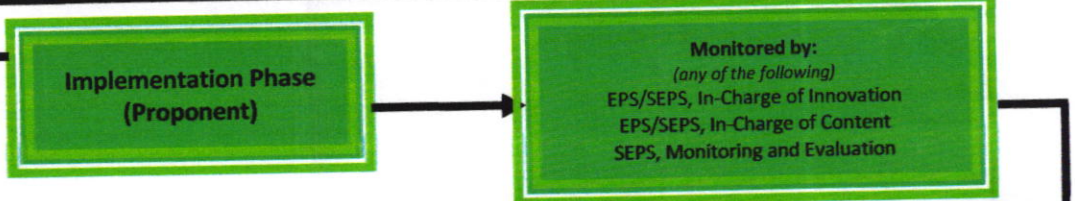


INNOVATION WORKFLOW

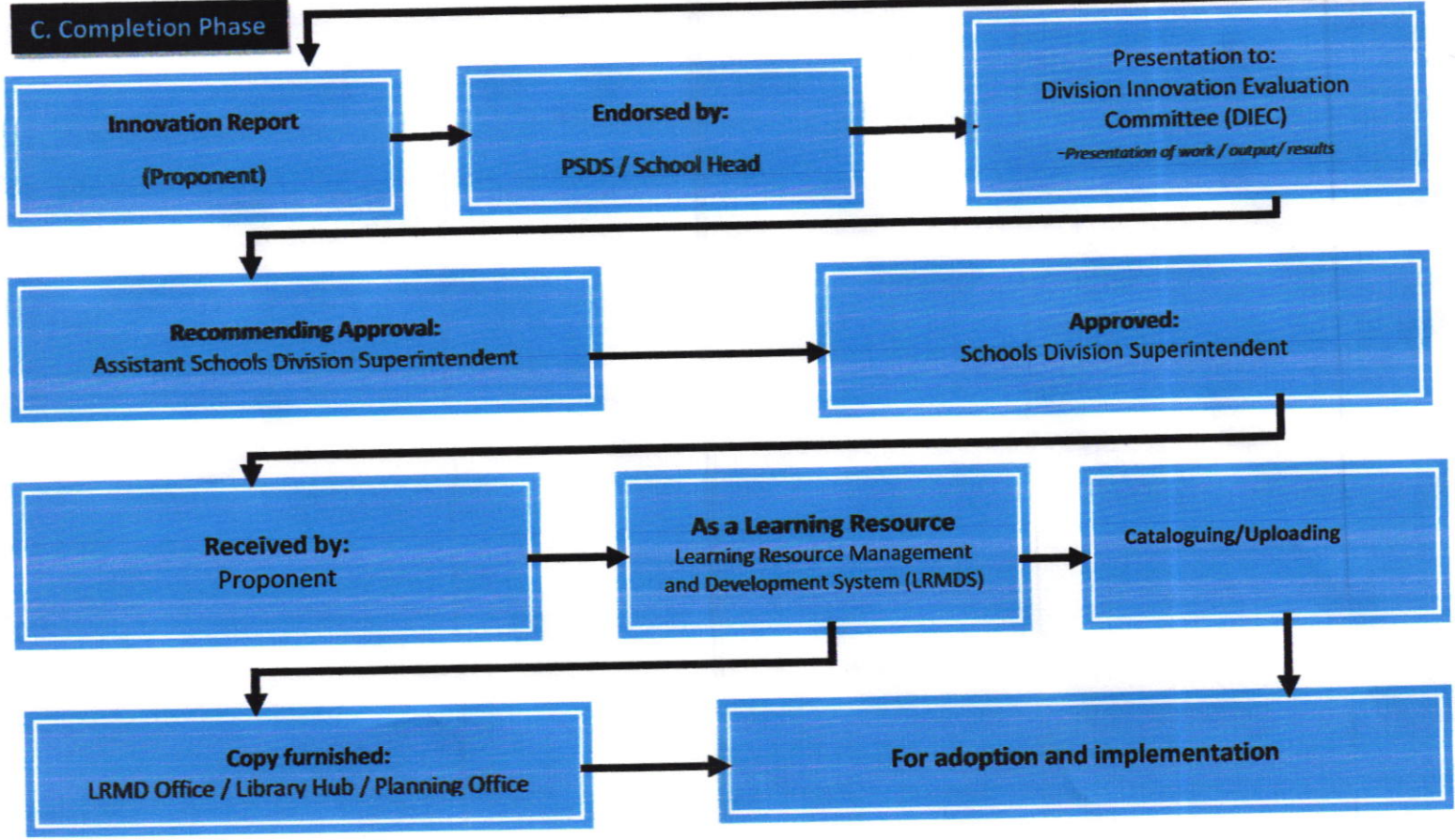
A. Proposal Phase

INNOVATION is the process of making changes to something established by introducing something new in educational programs, structure and system.

PRINCIPLES OF INNOVATION

1. New educational ideas or practices which were not previously known.
2. Adaption, extensions or modifications of earlier ideas. These are common forms of innovation.
3. Changed conditions (e.g. class size, better materials, auxiliary staffing) under previously unsuccessful innovations may be successful.
4. Change attitudes on the part of teachers or administrators towards idea.
5. New situations where the element combine in new ways. There will be a better mobilization of influences.
6. Changes which result from the spread of ideas, of which people had not previously heard, understood or seem potentially important.

 - Teaching Devices
 - Educational Games
- II. Effective Teaching Strategy
 - Approaches

 - Reporting System
 - Record Keeping
 - Procedures that resulted in cost reduction
