RE:

DISCOURAGING FUND RAISING ACTIVITIES IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS

- In compliance to Regional Memorandum No. 136, s. 2016, the Schools Division of Nueva Ecija is to implement a division-wide moratorium on all forms of fund raising activities in public schools pending evaluation of existing fund raising activities.
- 2. Pupils/students should not be burdened to support school programs and projects;
- 3. Likewise, teachers are not obliged to contribute, pay, and shell out any amount of their personal money for any fund raising activity.
- 4. To support various activities and programs of the school, school administrators are encouraged to strengthen the linkages and partnership with our external stakeholders thru our Adopt-A-School Program and maximize the utilization of our MOOE, proceeds of school canteens, and Special Education Funds.
- 5. Any violation of this Memorandum will be dealt accordingly in accordance with the revised DepEd rules of procedures in administrative cases.
- Immediate, wide dissemination and strict compliance to this memorandum is highly expected.

DISCOURAGING FUND RAISING ACTIVITIES IN PUBLIC SCHOOLSREGORDS SECTION

Regional Division Chiefs

- 1. The universal access to basic education is a sustained key thrust of the Department of Education, therefore, it necessitates the Regional Office to ensure that supporting policies to protect the right of every learner are sustainably enforced.
- 2. Public basic education is fully supported by the State as stipulated in Article XIV, Section 2 of the 1987 Constitution and RA 6655 (Free Public Secondary Act of 1988). Thus, pupils/students should not be burdened in generating funds to support school programs and projects.
- 3. Anent to the following and in conformance with Section 1 of RA 5546 (Ganzon Law) and MECS Order No. 73, s. 1985, pupils/students should not be engaged in any but not limited to the following activities which are similar in nature:
 - a) selling of raffle tickets
 - b) selling and playing of bingo cards
 - c) participating in popularity contests
 - d) soliciting financial donations through Pirma Ko, Tulong ko
 - e) participating in JS Promenade
 - f) patronizing film and stage shows
 - g) collection of contributions in any form whatsoever
- 4. Among the other pupils/students non-burdensome measures that can be adopted are the following:
 - a) School officials with their PTA Officers and SGCs are encouraged to strengthen their linkages with civic spirited individuals and groups/organizations for partnership as stipulated in RA 8525 (Adopt-A-School Program)



- b) School officials must judiciously utilize the MOOE and proceeds from school canteens as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 8, 2007.
- c) Schools Division Superintendents and public schools district supervisors must ensure the judicious utilization of the Special Education Fund to support eligible school programs and projects.
- 5. Teachers are likewise not obliged to contribute, pay, shell out any amount money for any fund raising activity.
- 6. All forms of fund raising activities in public schools will be on moratorium pending evaluation of existing fund raising activities.
- 7. Schools Division Superintendents are directed to closely monitor the implementation of this Memorandum. Any official/personnel who will be found violating this Memorandum shall be dealt with in accordance with the revised DepEd rules of procedures in administrative cases.
- 8. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum and strict compliance is hereby desired.
