**DIVISION TRAINING OF ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS 2017**

**TO:** Public Schools District Supervisor  
Elementary School Principals/Head Teachers/TICs  
School Paper Advisers

1. In compliance to R.A. 7079, an Act providing for the Development and Promotion of Campus Journalism, the Division Training of School Paper Advisers will be conducted on May 10-13, 2017 at Crystal Waves Hotel and Resort, Talavera, Nueva Ecija.
2. The training aims to:
  - a. equip newly appointed school paper advisers on the procedure and management of school publication;
  - b. upgrade the journalistic writing skills and level of competence of SPAs in the individual writing categories, collaborative Desktop Publishing, Radio Script Writing and Broadcasting and TV Broadcasting;
  - c. hone the journalistic competence of School Paper Advisers towards excellence and healthy and friendly competition in the Division Press Conference and
  - d. deepen appreciation and understanding on the very essence of journalism through an immersion with the Philippine Daily Inquirer and ABS-CBN News and Public Affairs
3. Participants to this training are selected school paper advisers (6/district), certificates of completion will be issued to them only upon submission of training requirements which include attendance and outputs every after session. They must bring their own laptops, camera, memory cards and other devices in case they will participate in the events requiring gadgets.
4. A registration fee of two thousand five hundred pesos (Php 2,500.00) shall be collected to cover meals for 3 days and transportation allowance relative to the immersion activities with the Philippine Daily Inquirer and ABS-CBN News and Public Affairs, chargeable to School Paper Fund/MOOE/Local Fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedure. Participants are advise to register in advance to ensure the exact number of attendees for reservation and provision for transportation.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is advised.
