2. The theme for the Station ID must be aligned to the application of ISO 90001:2015 of the division which means globally competitive standards.
3. All interested contestants must submit the needed requirements on or before August 20, 2018.

**MECHANICS FOR DIVISION STATION ID HYMN COMPOSITION CONTEST**

1. This competition is open to all permanent teaching and non-teaching personnel of SDO-NE.
2. The contestant must be any amateur composer/arranger itself and can only use interpreter or singer/s and instrumentalist/s in the realization of the composition.
3. All interested contestants must submit the needed requirements on or before August 20, 2018.
  - a) Letter of intent of the composer/arranger in joining the competition officially which must be addressed to the Superintendent noted by the immediate superior not later than August 20, 2018.
  - b) Hard copy of the musical arrangement of the composition including the lyrics from the introduction up to the finale part of your entry song with accompaniment.
  - c) Audio recording of the music saved in CD, one copy of mixed vocal and instrumental music plus one copy of minus one or instrumental music properly labeled.
4. The music can be recorded in any studio provided it's not in the commercial recording studio in the music industry. The entry song must at least with the duration of 3 to 5 minutes only.
5. The singer can be one male/female or mixed male and female as the composition requires in the harmony and creativity aspect.
6. The winners (Composer, Lyricist, Instrumentalist/s, Singer/s) of the SDO-NE Station ID will receive trophy, certificate and cash prize.
7. The criteria for judging:

Melody of the song -----	25%
Instrumentation -----	25%
Harmony/Interpretation-----	25%
Title/Lyrics Relevance to the theme-----	20%
Appeal and Musicality -----	5%
 TOTAL -----	 100%
8. Judges decision is final and un appealable.
9. The winning piece will be the official SDO-NE Station ID.
10. The final judging will be on August 31, 2018 at the Schools Division Office ICT/Function room.
