1. Presidential Proclamation No. 479 dated October 24, 1994 stipulates that the Filipino Values Month is celebrated every November of each year. The celebration aims to strengthen the Filipino culture, values and ideals that are Maka-Diyos, Maka-Tao, Makakalikasan at Makabansa. Furthermore, it hopes to mobilize all Filipinos for nation building through the practical exercise of human values in daily lives as citizens, and to awaken all of the power of these values and ideals in achieving the individual and national goals.
2. As part of the observance, DepEd Schools Division of Nueva Ecija will conduct a 3-day seminar/workshop for non-EsP major teachers teaching the subject on October 24-26, 2018 (venue to be announced later) prior to the celebration of Filipino Values Month to give way to the conduct of Regional Festival of Talents and Virtues.
3. Its aim is to mobilize teachers in bringing awareness to the importance of developing good character and positive attitude to teachers since they greatly influence the minds of the youth.
4. Travelling expenses of the participants shall be charged against MOOE/local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.
5. Wide dissemination of the content of this memorandum is earnestly desired.
