SUBJECT: **GUIDELINES FOR CD1-4 Meet for Elementary and Secondary – Private Schools**

1. Final submission of entries in all events for all CDs will be on September 28, 2018, Friday, at Nampicuan Christian Academy, Nampicuan, Nueva Ecija. All entries must be submitted in hard copy. Entries sent by email, texts, Facebook or messenger will NOT be entertained. No entries will be accepted after the given date.
2. Dates and venues of screening of athlete's documents for CD 1-4 meet in Elementary and Secondary
 - a. CD 1 and 2 – October 3 and 4, 2018 at REH Montessori College, Talavera, Nueva Ecija (Elementary and Secondary)
 - b. CD 3 and 4 – October 1 and 2, 2018 at Dr. Gloria Lacson Foundation Colleges, San Leonardo, Nueva Ecija (Elementary and Secondary)
3. Requirement for athletes (all must be typewritten in A4 paper)
 - a. Athlete record
 - b. PSA or NSO birth certificate, photocopy with original
 - c. Dental certificate
 - d. Parent's consent (or special guardian consent)
 - e. Medical certificate
 - f. Certificate of enrolment
 - g. 1.5 x 1.5 passport size picture with name, grade level and section (white background)
 - h. Coach and athlete gallery
4. Php200 per player per event and Php200 per school will be collected to cover up the expenses. Expenses are the following per CD for all CDs:

9. Awards
 - a. Group events – trophies (1st to 3rd place)
 - b. Individual events – medals (1st to 3rd place)Note: Only the 1st Place will advance to the higher meet.
10. If a player of a school that is adopted by the school competing in higher meet, and his/her school did not allow her to join, his/her school will be disqualified to join the competition the following school year.
11. All players whether competing in the CD meet or CD5 meet are required to register in the CD meet as official entry.
12. All referees will come from public schools for all meets of private schools.
13. Do not use code names in uniforms. Use your school name for your uniform.
14. Wear your PE uniform or sports outfit with number at the back for your identity.
15. Only coaches or school principals/heads are allowed to ask the coordinators/referees if problem occurs. The decision of the referee or game official is final.
16. Avoid unnecessary actions or fowl languages that will disqualify your group.
17. Each school must provide banners for each event they are joining.
