DIVISION POST EVALUATION OF THE SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM

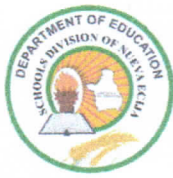
To: **Public Schools District Supervisors**
